# Winners Revealed for 2<sup>nd</sup> Annual ACG New York Champion's Awards

Top deals, firms and professionals honored before sell-out crowd Burt Alimansky, chairman, Capital Roundtable receives Peter Hilton Founder's Award

**NEW YORK, June 14, 2012** – ACG® New York, the premier association in New York for middle market dealmaking professionals, and The M&A Advisor announced last night the names of 35 winners of the second annual ACG New York Champion's Awards, recognizing companies, individual dealmakers and transactions in the middle market mergers and acquisitions industry in the greater New York area.

The winners, selected in eight different categories—including Middle Market Deal of the Year, Dealmaker of the Year, Firm & Product/Service of the Year, and Sector Deal of the Year--were celebrated by a sell-out audience of more than 225 at the ACG New York Champion's Awards Gala at Sotheby's New York. The evening also paid tribute to Burt Alimansky, chairman of Capital Roundtable, as the recipient of the Peter Hilton Founder's Award. The event was emceed by Kayla Tausche, a journalist covering corporate finance and deals for CNBC's "Business Day" programming.

Among the winners, George Sampas of Sullivan & Cromwell LLP, was named Dealmaker of the Year. The acquisition of Citadel Broadcasting Corporation by Cumulus Media, Inc. was recognized as the Middle Market Deal of the Year for transactions exceeding \$250 million in value. Golub Capital was honored as Senior Lender Firm of the Year, among recipients of Firm and Product/Service of the Year awards. See below for the full list.

An independent body of experts representing a cross-section of the middle market industry judged the finalists' deals, deal makers and firms. Selections were made from among 220 finalists. Firms with offices in New York, individuals active in New York and transactions conducted between April 1, 2011 and March 30, 2012 with a transaction value of more than \$5 million were eligible for the 2012 Awards.

Criteria used by the judges included the importance of the transaction, product, service or dealmaker to the industry and also the level of creativity, resourcefulness and perseverance it took to complete the deal.

The Peter Hilton Founder's Award is named for Peter Hilton, who in 1954 founded the Association for Corporate Growth, a global organization based in Chicago. ACG New York Inc. is the New York chapter.
